Instructions for use

Surface preparation:

Mating surfaces must be clean and dry, free from any dust or grease.

Application:

Apply a thin, uniform layer of BricoEasy Glue Stick to each of the surfaces to be bonded.

Join the two surfaces, pressing for a few seconds.

Remove excess glue with a damp cloth.

Dissolving and cleaning

Freshly-applied product may be removed using a cloth dampened with water.

Storage

Store the product in a cool, dry place in its original closed packaging at a temperature of between 5°C and 25°C. This product has an average life of 60 months.
